FOUNDATION

Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club first started as an organized activity for the First Hampton Scout Group by Norm (Boss) James in 1918. The Scout Group's main theme was to promote football as a team game and encourage self confidence, self control and a desire to improve a player's ability. This is similar to the current philosophy used by Hampton Rovers today.

Initially, games were played socially against other Scout Groups and then in the Association Sub-district competition. But, as the incentive to play a higher standard became apparent, another competition was sought and in 1933 Hampton Rovers was accepted into the Metropolitan Amateur Football competition which later became the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

In 1963 the Club moved from the Ludstone Street ground to the corner of David Street and Bluff Road, our present home. In 2002 this ground was formally named the "Boss James Reserve" in memory of our founder.

In 1979 the Club started its youth policy by introducing junior teams in an effort to provide an extensive link with the local community and to provide a development scheme for our senior side. Since 1979, 30 premierships, including three this season, Reserves, Under 9 and Under 10, have been won.

Three senior and 16 junior sides together with Auskick represented the Rovers in 2004. This year we had 474 registered players making the Rovers one of the biggest Australian Rules club in Australia and the world!!

Thus, from humble beginnings, the Players, Committee and loyal Supporters have nurtured Hampton Rovers over many years and assisted in creating the strong Family Club we are today.



The Hampton Rovers Hall of Fame was established in 2004 - the club's 75th Anniversary year. At the 75th Anniversary Dinner, held at the Brighton International on July 17, thirteen men were introduced into the Hall of Fame, eight of whom are living and five who are deceased.

2004 INDUCTEES

PETER WOLFE

Joined the Rovers in 1964. U19 most consistent award in 1965 & third in VAFA Best & Fairest despite only playing 12 games before being promoted to the Seniors. 1969 Club Best & Fairest. Senior captain in 1970 & 1971. Awarded Rovers Life Membership in 1974, also in that year won the seniors most determined player. Retired in 1977 after 212 games to accept a work transfer interstate. Returned to Victoria four years later and became Treasurer for three years, then became President for two years, and did another year as Treasurer in 1988. During his 40 years at the club he has held many other positions, such as General Committee Member, Social Committee Member, VAFA Delegate, Senior Runner, Boundary Umpire, Trainer and Chairman of Selectors. Was awarded the VAFA Certificate Of Merit in 1999. Took on Treasurer again this year for his ninth year in that position.

IAN CAVE

Started at the Rovers in 1965. Played 284 games with the club over two decades. Reserves coach for 8 years, in that time his charges played in 14 Finals matches for one flag (1979) and two runners up. Several stints on the Senior Committee – firstly between 1966 and 1972, then 1996 and 1999, and is back on board in 2004. Has been the Senior Vice President (one year), Club Secretary (3 years) and VAFA Delegate (5 Years). Was awarded Best Clubman in 1969. VAFA State Selector for 5 years and was on the VAFA Permit Committee for two years.

MAX GRIMMER

Playing career started in 1955 and concluded in 1994, playing a total of 208 games. Won the under 19 Best and Fairest in 1958 and won the VAFA Leading Goal kicker award in B Grade in 1960. Under 15 coach 1983-84, Under 17 coach 1985-87, Under 19 coach 1990. Awarded life membership in 1992. Best clubman in 1992 & 1995. Awarded VAFA Certificate of Merit in 2003. Has also filled the following positions: Vice President, Secretary. Been on the General Committee over many years. Football Manager, Team Trainer and Senior Stats man – something he still does today. Has also been the VAFA Delegate.

DON SCARLETT

Joined the Rovers in 1965 playing U19 football. Became a member of the Senior Committee in his early 20's in 1967. Took on the role of Club Treasurer in 1968-69. Won the Best Clubman award in 1970 - an award he won again in 1997 – nearly 30 years later. In 1971, he left the club to travel overseas and work interstate. Returned to the club in 1975 and resumed playing. Served on senior committee between 1976 & 78. Awarded Life Membership in 1977. Senior Club President between 1978 & 1981 and also in 1983. Retired from playing in 1984 with total 243 games. Senior Committee Member between 1984 & 1986. Assistant coach and Coach U17's between 1989 & 1991. Senior Coach between 1994 & 1997, including the 1995 premiership – the flag that broke a 40-year drought. Awarded VAFA Certificate of Merit in 1998. Member club coterie/sponsorship committee between 1999 & 2003. Chairman Board of Management 2003 & 2004.

GORDON MCGREGOR

Played 63 games for the Rovers in the 1960's. Under 19's coach in 1970 & 1971. Senior coach between 1972 & 1976. Reserves coach in 1974 & 1975. Senior coach again between 1982 & 1984. Club President in 1976 & 1977. Awarded VAFA Cert. of Merit in 1989. Yet another person whose family has a long association with the Rovers – and reinforcing the strong family orientation that is such a strong part of the Hampton Rovers.



COL ADAMSON

Played for the Rovers between 1945 & 1965 with a total of 312 games. Club captain 1954-1955 and between 1957 & 1961. Senior coach between 1960 & 1962 as well as in 1966. Reserves captain/coach in 1964. Club president in 1965.

BRIAN MCNAUGHTON

Played for the Rovers between 1962 & 1974 playing a total of 213 games. Described as a hard at the ball Ruck Rover who during his playing days was one of the fittest players at the club. Club captain 1968-1970 & 1972-1973. Club Best & Fairest in 1971 & 1972. Club President in 1974 & 1975.

ROSS SMITH

The most decorated player ever to wear the green and gold. Started with Hampton Scouts – the under 19s as they were then called – in 1958 and played 51 games between then and 1960. In 1961, started at St Kilda in the then VFL aged 19. Played 234 games for the Saints as a Rover. According the AFL Encyclopaedia of Football which has the records of every AFL/VFL footballer, his career really kicked off in St Kilda's Prelim Final win in 1966 – the biggest and clearly most successful year the club has had on the field. In 1967 he earned his Big V Guernsey and in that year won the games most coveted award – the Brownlow Medal with 24 votes. Won 2 Club Championships at St Kilda. Played in St Kilda's grand final team in 1971 when they were beaten by Hawthorn. Captained St Kilda from between 1970 and 1972. Captained Victoria in 1972. Headed West to coach Subiaco in the WAFL for three years, and in one of those won a flag. Coached the Saints in 1977. Ross Smith was inducted into the Rovers Hall of Fame under the clause relating to Meritorious Achievement at the highest level.

NORM "BOSS" JAMES (d)

Was the founder of our club in 1929. Although he only played 12 games, Norm "Boss" James was senior coach from 1929-1951 (club in recess 1941-1945) with the exception of 1933. He coached the seniors to premierships in 1939 (D Section), 1946 (C Section), 1947 (B Section) and 1951 (A Section). "Boss" was heavily involved with the Australian Scouting Movement and in 1918 he formed the Hampton Scout Group. In 1924 he organised a football match for the "local wild boys against his Hampton Scout Troup". The scout troop won and some of the "local louts" joined the scout group. In 1926 Boss contacted several other scout troops and formed a 6 team scout competition. In 1929 the Hampton Rovers joined the VAFA and the rest is history.

KEN TRINNICK (d)

Joined the club in 1933 and played approximately 100 games between 1933 and 1940. He won the VAFA Best & Fairest awards in 1933, 1934 and 1935 (all D Section) and the club Best & Fairest awards in 1934, 1935, 1936 and 1938. Doug was club captain from 1934 to 1938 and senior coach in 1954 and 1955. He was club president from 1958 to 1960.



SAM BIRTLES (d)

Joined the club in 1946 and played 100 plus games between 1946 and 1953. He won the A Section Best & Fairest award in 1949 and was the League's leading goalkicker in 1946 (119 goals in C Section) and 1949 (64 goals in A Section). Sam was club captain in 1952 and 1953, VAFA representative in 1947, 1949, 1950 and 1951. He played in the All Australian team in 1951 and coached the Rovers in 1964 and 1965. Sam was a fighter pilot during World War 2.

DOUG ARNOLD (d)

Joined the club in 1936 and played approximately 150 games between 1936 and 1952. He was club captain 1948-1951 including the 1951 A Section premiership year. He won the club Best & Fairest award in 1946 (C Section premiers), 1947 (B Section premiers), 1949 (shared with Sam Birtles) and 1951 (A Section premiers). Doug represented Hampton Rovers in the VAFA representative sides of 1948, 1949, 1950 and 1951. He was captain of each of these representative sides. He was also captain/coach of the All Australian Amateur side in 1952. Doug was captain of the Jubilee Lightning Premiership 1952 (Scouting Movement). Doug attended Wesley College and during his school days, he would play for the school in the morning and front up for the Rovers in the afternoon. Geelong Football Club wanted him to play for them but his answer was that he "played for enjoyment and I can get it all with the Rovers". Doug also served with the Australian Air Force during World War 2.

ROBERT CAVE (d)

Bob joined the club in 1935. He played 200 plus games between 1935 and 1950. He was premiership club captain in 1946 (C Section) and 1947 (B Section). Bob was club president from 1966 to 1968, club secretary in 1952 and 1955-1957. He received a VAFA Certificate of Merit in 1979. Robert Cave served in the Australian Air Force during World War 2.

Football Operations

Thanks also to Dallas Voss for his ground marking. Both sections of the club thank you for your commitment in performing this task each week.

WEBSITE REPORT

2004 was yet another ground breaking year for the Hampton Rovers AFC Website with over 81,000 people visiting the site. Almost 350,000 pages were viewed in total, meaning an average of just over 4 pages per visit. The most popular month was August when the site was visited 11,088 times.

A major introduction this year was online membership which enables people to register and then view members-only sections of the site. Not only did this improve security, it also created a sense of community. By the end of the season, 430 people had registered. Of these, 353 people subscribed to the 'e-Newsletter', a weekly newsletter sent out via email.

The Rovers website includes all the latest club news, details of upcoming events, fixtures and results for all senior and junior games, match details and match reports for senior games, game/goal stats for all senior and junior players, club history and much more.

Another popular feature continues to be the forum, especially amongst senior players. There are now close to 5,500 messages on the board and over 100 members.

For the first time, a multimedia section was introduced mid way through the season which allows online members with broadband internet access to download video highlights of senior games. This was an instant hit with many visits to the section.

2004 was a massive year and the site will only grow next year and in the seasons to come. New exciting features are planned to further enhance the VAFA's most popular club website.

On a personal note, I'd like to thank David Rogerson for compiling and providing me with all the game & goal stats, Greg Downes for senior match reports, Sally Williams and Richard May for junior fixtures and results as well as Robyn Funston and Paul Pavlou for various junior content.
