FOUNDATION

Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club first started as an organized activity for the First Hampton Scout Group by Norm (Boss) James in 1918. The Scout Group's main theme was to promote football as a team game and encourage self confidence, self control and a desire to improve a player's ability. This is similar to the current philosophy used by Hampton Rovers today.

Initially, games were played socially against other Scout Groups and then in the Association Sub-district competition. But, as the incentive to play a higher standard became apparent, another competition was sought and in 1933 Hampton Rovers was accepted into the Metropolitan Amateur Football competition which later became the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

In 1963 the Club moved from the Ludstone Street ground to the corner of David Street and Bluff Road, our present home. In 2002 this ground was formally named the "Boss James Reserve" in memory of our founder.

In 1979 the Club started its youth policy by introducing junior teams in an effort to provide an extensive link with the local community and to provide a development scheme for our senior side. Since 1979, 32 junior premierships, including three this season – Under 10 Gold, U14 & U15 – have been won.

The Rovers have won seven senior premierships including the 'A' Section flag in 1951. Nine reserve and seven under 19 premierships have also been won by the club.

Three senior and seventeen junior sides represented the Rovers in 2006, equating to 542 registered players, plus almost 100 kids participating in Auskick, making the Rovers one of the largest Australian Rules Football clubs.

Thus, from humble beginnings, the Players, Committees and loyal Supporters have nurtured Hampton Rovers over many years and assisted in creating the strong Family Club we are today.

SENIOR PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I am pleased to present members with my report for the 2006 football season.

Football Operations

Unfortunately 2006 was a disappointing year for the senior club with the Club being relegated to D1 next season. Whilst this is not something we like to occur, it will give the Club time to refocus and rebuild for what will hopefully be a more successful 2007 season.

I sincerely hope, and it is extremely important, that all players stay with the Club next season to assist in its rebuilding with the focus being a return to "C" Grade in 2007. Winning games and playing in finals is what we must always aim for and I am certain that when this starts to happen, as I am sure it will, the whole club will lift, atmosphere and enthusiasm will return and we will all have an enjoyable 2007.

Prior to the commencement of the 2006 season the Club lost a number of players overseas, interstate and to other clubs and a number of younger players from the previous years under 19's, who we would normally be relied upon to move through to the seniors and bolster numbers, decided for various reasons not to play. During the season we lost further players overseas and once again a number of our better players succumbed to injury for significant periods of time. At one stage about two thirds of the way into the season, we had 12-14 senior players unavailable. Injuries and player loss saw in excess of 50 players being played through the seniors during the season and many more through the reserves.

The positive outcome of this was the excellent potential shown by a significant number of under 19 players when they were given the opportunity to play in both the seniors and reserves. Many have shown that they are ready-made senior players and will be very good players for the Club for many years to come.

Our Senior Coach, **Brett McIlwraith**, stood down at the end of the season and I would like to thank Brett for his efforts over the previous three seasons and I wish he and his family all the very best for the future.

Thanks also to **Chris Gawne** for assisting Brett throughout the season and I wish him well in his endeavours to find a senior coaching position. And once again to **David Rogerson** for his assistance with pre-season training, normal training nights, pre-match warm-ups and as senior runner. David has carried out these duties for many years and his efforts are greatly appreciated.

This year was probably even more difficult than the previous years as far as fielding a reserve side and once again I would like to thank **Anthony Naumoff** for undertaking the most difficult task of coaching the reserves and ensuring that we were able to get through the season without a forfeit.



Thanks also to all of the **under 19 players** who assisted the senior and reserve teams during the year and also to all the other players who answered Freddie's call for assistance and turned up each week to ensure that we were able to field a reserves side.

Cam McGregor did an excellent job this year with the Under 19's who just missed out on playing in the finals. Had so many of the 19's players not have been required to play in the seniors during the season I am certain that the result would have been even better. Thanks also to **Steve Guy, Scott and Blair McGregor** and all of the other people who assisted with the Under 19's this year.

I would also like to thank all the other people who helped out with the Seniors and Reserves this season – **Michael Lake** (Senior Team Manager and other things) **Max Grimmer** (Reserve team manager and many other things) **Graham Carr** (Goal Umpire, Scoreboard and Can Bar) **Jason Cave** (Interchange) **Ian Cave** (Time Keeper) **Athol Porter** (Reserve Time Keeper, Banners and Lunches) **Cam Voss** (Video) **Denis Flynn** (Water etc.) **Ian Rootsey** (Reserve Boundary) **Adam Ross** (Reserves Umpire) **Stephen Hope** (Scoreboard) and the various other people who assisted with statistics, water, running etc. throughout the year. 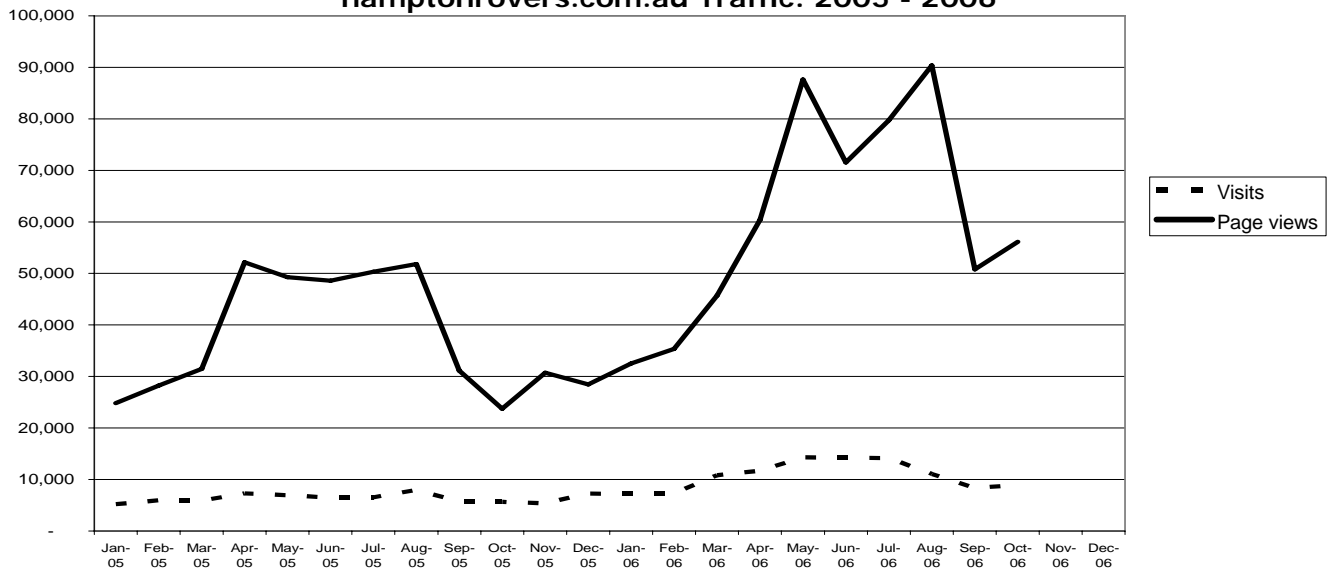
WEBSITE REPORT

2006 was another outstanding year for the Hampton Rovers website, once again proving its status as not only one of the leading websites in the VAFA, but one of the club sites in Australia outside of the AFL. Visitor numbers almost doubled in 2006 and it's worth noting the least popular month was almost the same figure as the most popular month in 2005 in terms of visitor numbers. Up to the end of November, the Rovers website was visited 108,117 times (avg 296 p/day) compared to 63,702 for the same period in 2005. A total of 610,205 pages were viewed compared to 391,557 for last year. That's an average of 5.6 pages per visit to the site and 1,667 pages per day. The most popular sections of the site were the news and results sections, while the player stats also proved popular, as did the forum. The site was given a touch-up prior to the season with a number of features added throughout the year. Websites remain one of the most important communication tools for a club, and the Rovers website will continually be enhanced into the future.

Hopefully this taste of senior football will create hunger to success as Hampton Rovers footballers, and they can create a little of their own history, as senior premiership players of this fabulous football club.

To the playing group, I thank you for the support you have shown over the past three years and as unsuccessful as we have been, I wouldn't have missed the journey for anything. Most games we have played in that three year period have been an arm wrestle. In situations like we experienced, it can fast track the development of leaders within the club or limit their development in those areas, as players struggle with their own form first and foremost, and unfortunately this has been the case.

I would like to thank Peter Blick, Jenny Voss, Max Grimmer, Graham Carr, Michael Lake and Jan McGregor for their support over the journey. Cam Voss for his invaluable videoing and Cam McGregor for being a terrific Under 19 coach, and one who encourages his boys to take the next step.

To the pre-season training boys, Browney, Parko and Trigger, you did a fantastic job, hopefully you're given another go.

Hampton Rovers would not be the great place it is if Freddie and Rogo weren't a part of it. I swear, if you cut either of these two guys, they would have green and gold blood in their veins. They do a fantastic job every week for this footy club.

To my mate Gawney, yet again we've had fun, we've argued, we've fought – wouldn't have missed it for the world. The last thing a coach needs is someone who thinks the same way, to the two of us have no worried there.

In conclusion, the thought of Hampton Rovers playing in D Grade is not palatable, even to me, and I won't be involved with the club in 2007, however I would like to think all current players will go around next year. After an extremely disappointing season on field for the Senior Club and consequently being relegated to D Section, there were some real positives from the U19s. Without previous exposure to coaching at this level, I took the approach of maximising the enjoyment and exposure of all 38 players to both senior and reserve football. With 38 players, list management was crucial for both short and long term success at this club. We implemented a rotation policy at the start of the season, which grouped the players into 6's and they were to play 3 games each in the reserves. This was applied for two reasons, the first being the reserves were struggling for numbers and secondly to allow these kids to play football when we couldn't fit them into the u/19s.

Whilst in theory this was a great idea, the team never was never settled, so by round 8 we decided to forgo the previous arrangement and pick the side on training attendance, availability and performances, however we continued to ensure everyone had to play some reserves football. Throughout the course of the year we lost 5 players to season ending injuries and only 2 players decided not to continue. These figures are extremely pleasing and a credit to all involved.

Whilst we started with 3 losses and turned at the halfway mark 3 wins, 6 losses, we had in place a simple but effective team plan and consequently we finished much better in the second half of the year, eventually finishing 5th with 9 wins, 9 losses. Excellent numbers at training allowed us to practice match day drills and this was evident later in the year. We have 24 of the 38 players still eligible for u/19s next year, so we can expect increased improvement and hopefully a finals appearance.

I will start my thank you with the Playing group. I don't think you could find a better 38 players who get on so well, who love the club, love training and more importantly are tremendous individuals. You were a pleasure to be involved with and I hope the guys going up, stick with the club and play senior football and the others come back and play u/19s in 2007. To the leaders, Lee Smith as Captain, Rory White and Jason McCoy as both VC and DVC as well as the leadership group, thanks. Congratulations to all the trophy winners including Kyle Pinto, who polled 3rd in the VAFA vote count.

To my helpers, Scott McGregor who ran all year and who opened his house for a social get together, your assistance was much appreciated. Steve Guy was Team Manger and filled in as either timekeeper or goal umpire most weeks. Dean Vine, Blair McGregor and Karl Peace all helped either as Assistant Coaches, boundary umpires or as water boys. Katherine (Frog) our head trainer, your knowledge and expertise was enormous. It was fantastic to know we had the right medical staff on hand and I thank both you and Lucy for being great trainers.
