## FOUNDATION

Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club first started as an organised activity for the First Hampton Scout Group by Norm (Boss) James in 1918. The Scout Group's main theme was to promote football as a team game and encourage self confidence, self control and a desire to improve a player's ability. This is similar to the current philosophy used by Hampton Rovers AFC today.

Initially, games were played socially against other Scout Groups and then in the Association Sub-district competition. But, as the incentive to play a higher standard became apparent, another competition was sought and in 1933, Hampton Rovers was accepted into the Metropolitan Amateur Football competition which later became the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

In 1963 the club moved from its Ludstone Street ground to the corner of David Street and Bluff Road, our present home. In 2002 this ground was formally named the "Boss James Reserve" in memory of the club's founder.

In 1979 the Hampton Rovers AFC started its youth policy by introducing junior teams in an effort to provide an extensive link with the local community and to provide a development scheme for the senior side. Since then, 28 junior premierships have been won, including four this season: U14 Div1, U13 East, U12 South & U11 West.

The Rovers have won seven Senior premierships, and were the first club to win premierships in each of the four senior sections, including the 'A' Section flag in 1951. Nine Reserve and seven Under 19 premierships have also been won by the club.

Three Senior and fourteen Junior sides represented the Rovers in 2008, equating to 510 registered players, plus 178 kids participating in the Auskick program, making the Hampton Rovers one of the largest Australian Rules Football clubs.

## SENIOR PRESIDENT'S REPORT

To commence, I would like to say how proud I was to of held such a position. I believe the club has built a tremendous foundation in past years to allow the current board & playing group to enjoy the riches they are currently in. As President in 2008, it shows that a football club with the right people within can achieve anything, although I think we can still improve in many areas, the achievements by various individuals has been superb. Our year had many targets & one of which was to continue our commitment to giving back to the community with again holding a "Ladies Night" which supported two very worthwhile causes in "Ovarian Cancer" and "Beyond Blue". Gary Sheldon was re appointed after a great first season as senior coach, whilst Paul Curry replaced Richard Bulmer as reserves coach and Anthony Quon replaced Cameron McGregor as Under 19's coach. All coaches worked cohesively and were aware of the game plan which Gary Sheldon wanted the senior team to play under, thus ensuring all players from any team knew what their role was when they played in the senior side. The senior side made an impressive start to the year, winning the first 9 straight games and finishing the season on top of the ladder which was a terrific effort in itself after being promoted, and I have since been told it was the first time since the "40's" that our senior side has gone through the season on top of the ladder from Round 1 to Round 18 (equal top Round 1). The senior side competed in 3 finals games and they unfortunately were beaten in the Grand Final, many would say they played their Grand Final the week prior against Oakleigh. All the players who contributed throughout the year along with all the coaching staff have to be congratulated for such a season which has now elevated the club into "B" grade for 2009. Paul Curry took the reigns as the Reserves coach this year. It can often be a very difficult job, however Paul was able to get a full team on the park each week. Although the Reserves didn't make the finals, they finished 5<sup>th</sup> which was a good effort considering the ever changing squads that were playing week to week. The under 19's completed another successful year which saw them again compete in the finals, this time they were knocked out in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semi against De La Salle. Anthony Quon was terrific with all the players. At one stage in the pre season it looked as though they would struggle for numbers, however with the dedication of Anthony and his coaching staff we saw the start of the year commence with a full squad and at some stages throughout the year too many.

I believe 2009 will continue to be a launching pad for the senior section of the club to continue the growth, we should be proud of our efforts to date in becoming one of only two District Clubs in B grade. However we need to strive for "A" grade and with everyone on the same page I believe this feat can be achievable in the coming years. Congratulations to all involved with the football operations.

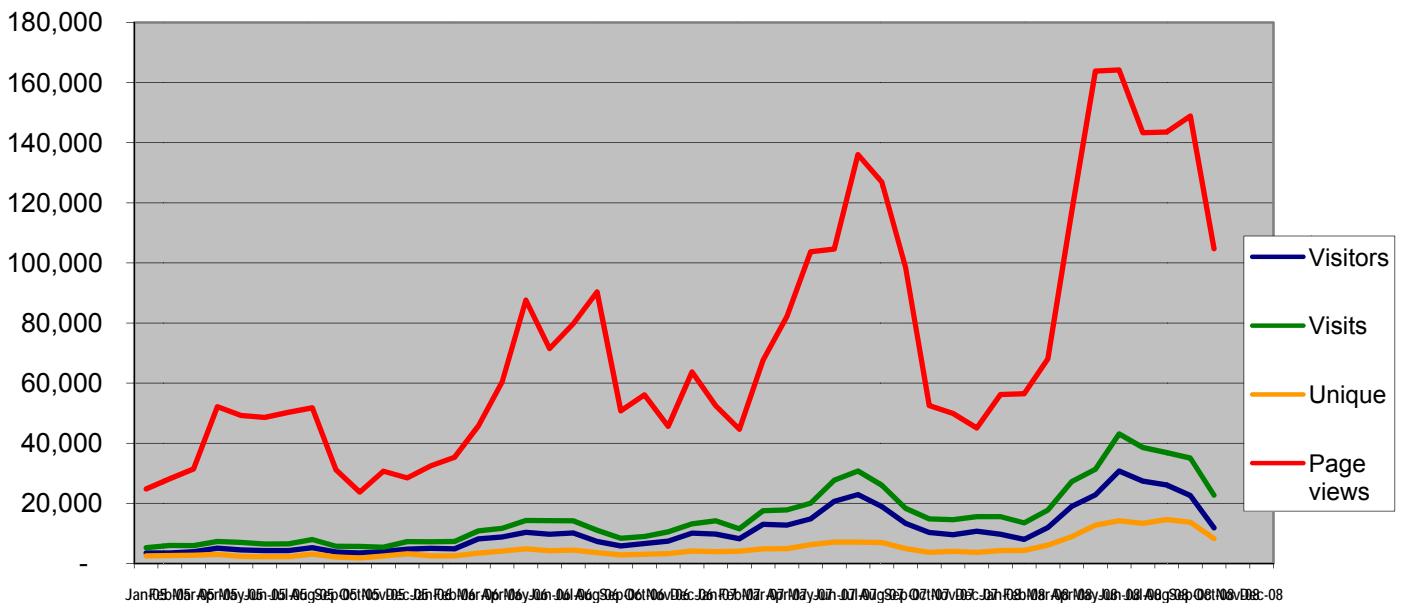
## WEBSITE REPORT

The Hampton Rovers website once again went from strength to strength in 2008 with a brand new design and increased traffic. Up to the end of October, the site was visited a total of 281,538 times (compared to 198,730 in '07, 108,117 in '06 and 63,702 in '05) and a total of 1,166,343 pages were viewed (compared to 869,342 in '07, 610,205 in '06 and 391,557 in '05). This year as well as a new design and layout with new menu navigation, we introduced team pages for all 17 Rovers teams, featuring team news, player stats and team details. Thanks to those who submitted match reports throughout the season. We also introduced a junior email newsletter sent to all junior parents, to add to the existing club eNewsletter. Another addition was satellite maps for senior ground locations. 2008 also saw the new Rovers mobile site launched, giving users the ability to view a mobile-enhanced version of the website on their mobile phone, which proved popular. Thanks to everyone who contributed to the site, including Paul Pavlou for the junior game and goal stats and Berk McGowan for his outstanding photos throughout the year and at the senior presentation night.

## JUNIOR PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2008 has been a great year for the Juniors on a number of levels. However, for me the definition of success is getting nearly 400 players a regular game of football. Anything else achieved is a bonus.

### Teams

We started the season with 15 teams from under 9s to under 17s, but after a couple of games our under 16 team folded through not being able to get enough players to turn up for games. Fortunately, we were able to get those who wanted a regular game of club football a season with East Sandy, which worked well.

As we had 30 players in our under 14s, which is too many for one team and not enough for two, we made an arrangement for seven players on a volunteer basis to have a season with East Sandy. This ensured that all players got a decent amount of game time that would not have occurred otherwise and it helped out East Sandy with their numbers. This level of cooperation with East Sandy was beneficial to both clubs.

In our under 12s and 13s we decided in conjunction with the relevant coaches to run with two teams in each age group rather than three as had occurred the previous year. This meant we went from having teams last year regularly requiring players to play up from the younger age group to make up the numbers, to having more than 25 players in each squad this year and having to roster players off. We understand that neither situation is ideal but thank all those involved with dealing with the situation as best as possible.

### Finals

Our three under 9 and two under 10 teams played in lightning premierships at the end of their season and all put in great efforts with varying levels of success.

Eight of our nine teams in the under 11s to 17s made the finals in their respective divisions with five making the grand final and four taking out the premiership. The premier teams were:

Under 14 Division 1  
Under 13 East  
Under 12 South  
Under 11 West

Our Under 12 East team was runner up. Well done to all players involved.

### MSJFL Best and Fairest and Representatives

We were also very fortunate to have five boys win the best and fairest in their league Divisions this year and several boys were placegetters. Their names are reproduced elsewhere in the Annual Report.

Similarly, we had twelve boys play in under 13 and 14 MSJFL teams this year which is a great honour and it gave them the opportunity to play football at a higher level.

Our other Committee members included Karen Whalebone (team managers), Forbes James (treasurer), Brian Coughlan (MSJFL representative), Tim Edgecombe (ground allocation), Shayne Oswald and Chris Toouli (sponsorship).

Greg Bott completed his fourth year running the wine raffle with the generous support of his wife Cathy which raised more than \$12,000 this year and approximately \$50,000 over the four years. This is a fantastic effort raising much needed funds for the Club.

Other helpers not on the Committee included Kathie Sturgess (property), Jennie Jones (team photos), Michelle Curtis (Salvation Army collection), Marie Turner (trophies), Alison Witherow (registrations and club bookkeeper), Cath Champion (canteen) and with the help of her husband, Michael (Home with the Rovers). The Club is indebted to these people who give of their time tirelessly and help make the Club run so smoothly.
