## FOUNDATION

Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club first started as an organised activity for the First Hampton Scout Group by Norm (Boss) James in 1918. The Scout Group's main theme was to promote football as a team game and encourage self confidence, self control and a desire to improve a player's ability. This is similar to the current philosophy used by Hampton Rovers AFC today.

Initially, games were played socially against other Scout Groups and then in the Association Sub-district competition. But, as the incentive to play a higher standard became apparent, another competition was sought and in 1933, Hampton Rovers was accepted into the Metropolitan Amateur Football competition which later became the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

In 1963 the club moved from its Ludstone Street ground to the corner of David Street and Bluff Road, our present home. In 2002 this ground was formally named the "Boss James Reserve" in memory of the club's founder.

In 1979 the Hampton Rovers AFC started its youth policy by introducing junior teams in an effort to provide an extensive link with the local community and to provide a development scheme for the senior side. Since then, 28 junior premierships have been won.

The Rovers have won seven Senior premierships and were the first club to win premierships in each of the four senior sections, including the 'A' Section flag in 1951. Nine Reserve and eight Under 19 premierships (including the 2009 flag) have also been won by the club.

Four Senior and fifteen Junior sides represented the Rovers in 2009, equating to 465 registered players, plus 198 kids participating in the Auskick program, making the Hampton Rovers one of the largest Australian Rules Football clubs.

## SENIOR PRESIDENT'S REPORT

We introduced a fourth senior side being the club 18's, this was to ensure every person that wished to play at the club would be able to get a game on a Saturday, we also felt that going forward having a Third XVIII team would eventually further strengthen the Senior list and give greater depth to the overall Senior Club.

Again there was a Ladies Night held which continues to grow and the support for that was great, this function is an annual event which donates a percentage of the profits to a worthwhile charity, this year went to Michael Mitchell's "Great Australian Cancer Bush Walk".

Finally it was to achieve the height of previous years on field, we feel that the year was successful for all teams, although the ladder doesn't show this, apart from the Under 19's – we feel that the seniors will grow and really push for a finals spot in 2010.

### Football Operations:

Well 2009 saw the re-introduction of the Thirds or Club 18 team, many were very sceptical of this decision as we have often found numbers dwindle in the latter part of the season in the reserves, however the result was incredible for the club. We gave an opportunity to many who wouldn't have played this year if it wasn't for the Thirds & there wasn't a time throughout the season where one team was short of numbers. We must say this is a credit to both Glenn Roulet (Thirds coach) & Rod Haverfield (Thirds Team Manager).

Coming off yet another year of promotion for the Senior Side it was a relative unknown how we would perform in B Grade, it must be said it is quite a jump from C Grade. From the outset it showed that the competition was a lot classier, fast paced and the skills were at a high level. Our boys were extremely competitive all year, which ended the season with six wins which included a relegation battle and win for the Hampton Rovers at Boss James Reserve against our long time rival Ormond by a slender four points which kept our goal alive of making it to A grade within the next few years. A big thank you is to go to our outgoing coach Gary Sheldon who steered the club from D1 to B Grade in the course of three years, throughout this period he showed great passion and instilled many qualities into the senior side.

Our Reserves had a tough year as B Grade proved to show that depth is very important, however the club's depth is slowly getting better and with commitment from all players, will assist in making the club a powerhouse of the VAFA in coming years. Once again Paul Curry did an outstanding job in giving each and every Reserve player quality game time & encouragement to get better and learn.

The Under 19's were the success for the senior section of the club in 2009, they reached the Semi Final in 2008, however as it is with the 19's with the obvious change in personnel from year to year, it was seen to be a building year as the great majority of players were bottom age coming up from our Under 17's team. This couldn't be further from reality, the boys committed to each other and trained hard all year and it showed with finishing the home and away season on top of the ladder. They then went on to achieve the ultimate success in winning the South 2 Grand Final. As mentioned above this is an even greater effort seeing as though 24 out of the 28 are still eligible for under 19's again next year. The under 19's also gave the senior section of the club the proud achievement of having a team promoted in three successive years with the senior side twice and the under 19's who will be elevated to Under 19's South Division 1. A huge congratulation to Anthony Quon for his great efforts with our boys and he was further rewarded by being awarded the Under 19 Coach of the Year by the VAFA and AFCA. Also a big thank you to Dean Lovig for his incredible organisational skills with the under 19's.

Finally the thirds, well if you look at the ladder you would think it was an unsuccessful year, however from a club and many players point of view it was extremely successful. The implementation of the Thirds team saw the club register around 50 new players over the course of the season and although we didn't achieve a whole heap of on-field success we did achieve a team which were never short and gave an opportunity to many beginners and or players that thought their time had passed. The club was ecstatic when they achieved their first and only win against the second-placed Ormond – with many players learning the club song there and then and with the help of a few of the older boys. We are excited by the possibility of improvement with the thirds in the coming years & as per the opening it couldn't have been achieved without the assistance of Glenn and Rod.

I feel our football operations is in a very strong position for 2010, we have youth who are pushing through and putting pressure on our senior players, with the new appointment of Matt Robbins as senior coach there is a great vibe around the place and one of belief that this group really can achieve the goal of getting to A grade. Congratulations to all involved with the football operations.

Despite winning just the one game in their inaugural season, the introduction of the new Thirds team (or "The Clubbies") in 2009 was very successful for the Hampton Rovers. The main aim of the team was to provide an additional 26 playing opportunities every Saturday (with eight allowed on the bench) and to strengthen the Reserves which the club saw as vital in becoming a successful B grade club and to assist in achieving our aim of reaching A grade. It would also prove to be the ideal environment for those players not necessarily up to playing B grade reserves or those wishing to have a bit of a kick without training two nights a week.

The team had a good core of players such as Liam Woodland, Elies El Chaar, Tony Kavanagh, Nathan Foster and Tom Wills, Michael Flahive played when he could, Matt Terech played a handful of games and several players joined throughout the year including Nigel Guthrie, Ash Pratt and Jason Laver, just to name a few. And not to forget a cameo one-game appearance by club legend Stephen Anderson.

That one elusive win came in Round 12 at home against arch rivals Ormond. The guys has been improving every game and they knew a win wasn't far away. But against the second-top side on the ladder with just the two defeats? Maybe they did had their injury woes, but we won't let that get in the way of a feel-good story! The Rovers kicked with the gale force wind in the opening term and conceded the first goal, however responded well by kicking the next four. Holding a 19 point lead at quarter time, the Rovers managed to hold Ormond goalless with the wind in the second while kicking a goal of their own. The third term was all green and gold with the Rovers kicking three and Ormond failing to score. A 41-point lead at the last change was reduced to 26 points at the final siren. That's a 163-point turnaround from the season opener. The guys lapped it up after the game and for some, it was the first time ever they had belted out the club song.

A big thanks to Coach Glenn "Gladdys" Roulent who did a great job throughout the year and even managed to pull the boots on a few occasions. Also to Team Manager Rod "Bluey" Haverfield who also did a very good job coming in cold. Thanks also to the other regular helpers throughout the year, especially to Denis Pilkington who goal umpired most games.

The club will now build on the inaugural year of the Thirds and look forward to an even stronger year in 2010. Hopefully we'll have more people willing to put up their hand to help out, not only with the Thirds, but in various roles throughout the club.
