## **FOUNDATION**

Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club first started as an organised activity for the First Hampton Scout Group by Norm (Boss) James in 1918. The Scout Group's main theme was to promote football as a team game and encourage self-confidence, self-control and a desire to improve a player's ability. This is similar to the current philosophy used by Hampton Rovers AFC today.

Initially, games were played socially against other Scout Groups and then in the Association Sub-district competition. But, as the incentive to play a higher standard became apparent, another competition was sought and in 1933, Hampton Rovers was accepted into the Metropolitan Amateur Football competition which later became the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

In 1963 the club moved from its Ludstone Street ground to the corner of David Street and Bluff Road, our present home. In 2002 this ground was formally named the "Boss James Reserve" in memory of the club's founder.

In 1979 the Hampton Rovers AFC started its youth policy by introducing junior teams in an effort to provide an extensive link with the local community and to provide a development scheme for the senior side. Since then, 28 junior premierships have been won.

The Rovers have won seven senior premierships and were the first club to win premierships in each of the four senior VAFA sections, including the 'A' Section flag in 1951. Nine Reserve and eight Under 19 premierships have also been won by the club.

Four senior and sixteen junior sides represented the Rovers in 2010, equating to over 500 registered players, plus around 200 kids participating in the Auskick program, making the Hampton Rovers one of the largest Australian Rules Football clubs.

- A very exciting 2 point win at the tail-end of the season against a hard-charging St Kilda – coming from behind and having been out-played most of the game, they boys simply dug deep and never gave up.
- Their good sportsmanship after a close, heartbreaking loss against a fancied side where there was abuse hurled at them all game and some 'decisions' made (that in their eyes) cost them the game. The boys just kept at it and played great football. Whilst they may have left the ground with a loss, they knew within themselves, they were the better team
- As the season progressed, their ability to link-up and run the ball with numbers.
- Shepherding, shepherding, shepherding – it's great to see U9's protecting their teammates
- Whilst often very slow to get started in a game, the boys became renowned for their ability to come home with a second half surge. We quite often witnessed games of two very different halves!
- Some of the most courageous 'little' players I've ever seen, never scared to take on some of the biggest U9 boys.

As I mentioned earlier, probably the best part about coaching such a young group of boys was to witness the amazing change from the beginning to the end of the season. The teamwork by the end of the season was improving but it was the shepherding and the handing-off to a running teammate that really impressed. These are things not often seen in U9 games.

Whilst the boys were always very excited when coming away with a win, I think both myself and the parents were far more excited when they linked-up and played genuine 'team' football – it's wonderful to watch.

The boys were really starting to gel by the end of the 12 home and away games and were looking forward to the Lightning Premiership. While they didn't fare as well as they would have liked, they did take, arguably the top side (who thrashed them earlier in the season) to a real nail-biter, nearly getting the win. It was one of the best games I've seen from such a young group of boys. All the parents could see afterwards, while obviously disappointed, the boys themselves knew they'd come a long way as a team and had played good football.

We enjoyed great support from the parents all season and we had a wonderful group each week helping out – Katie Murray, Matt Larkworthy, Pete Flockart, Al Maddern to name but a few and of course my wife Miranda for doing a fabulous job with the management duties.

Being my first year as a junior coach, I think my learning curve was as steep as the boys under my care but it would be fair to say we all had a great season. Our focus for the season had always been on improving the boys individual skills but to play the game for each-other. Even more importantly, was for them to enjoy playing the game.

We asked the boys who wanted to come back and play next year – every single hand shot straight up without hesitation!!

It was a privilege to be involved with such a talented, polite and enthusiastic group of boys - I'll be watching their progress over the coming years with great interest.

Looking forward to next year.
