FOUNDATION

Hampton Rovers Amateur Football Club first started as an organised activity for the First Hampton Scout Group by Norm (Boss) James in 1918. The Scout Group's main theme was to promote football as a team game and encourage self-confidence, self-control and a desire to improve a player's ability. This is similar to the current philosophy used by Hampton Rovers AFC today.

Initially, games were played socially against other Scout Groups and then in the Association Sub-district competition. But, as the incentive to play a higher standard became apparent, another competition was sought and in 1933, Hampton Rovers was accepted into the Metropolitan Amateur Football competition which later became the Victorian Amateur Football Association.

In 1963 the club moved from its Ludstone Street ground to the corner of David Street and Bluff Road, our present home. In 2002 this ground was formally named the "Boss James Reserve" in memory of the club's founder.

In 1979 the Hampton Rovers AFC started its youth policy by introducing junior teams in an effort to provide an extensive link with the local community and to provide a development scheme for the senior side. Since then, 28 junior premierships have been won.

The Rovers have won seven senior premierships and were the first club to win premierships in each of the four senior VAFA sections, including the 'A' Section flag in 1951. Nine Reserve and eight Under 19 premierships have also been won by the club.

Four senior and sixteen junior sides represented the Rovers in 2011, equating to over 550 registered players, plus around 160 kids participating in the Auskick program, making the Hampton Rovers one of the largest Australian Rules Football clubs.

JUNIOR PRESIDENT'S REPORT

2011 was an excellent year for Hampton Rovers Juniors, with a number of teams competing in finals and two premierships being won. Most importantly, the club provided an environment for boys and girls to participate in our great game, all the way from Auskick to Under 17.

Teams

A total of 434 kids played football in across our 18 teams in 2011. This included three Under 9 teams all the way through to Under 16. A highlight of the year was the clubs involvement in the formation of the Girls Football – Check-Kick – where we fielded 2 teams in the inaugural MSJFL Girls Under 12 competition.

Of note was the joint team the club fielded with Beaumaris for the Under 15 Division 3 competition. From not being able to field a second side, to then seeing the club provide footy for these kids this year was tremendous.

It has been particularly pleasing to see 2 Under 14, 2 Under 15 and 2 Under 16 teams field in 2010, which should provide an excellent platform for later years.

Our Under 11 and Under 13 groups fielded just one team this year, which provides the club a challenge to improve our representation in those years.

Our Auskick program had in excess of 150 children register this year covering Kinder to Grade 2.

Finals

Paul Bowden was again our Vice-President Football. Paul led the coaching and football front of the club with passion contributing countless hours to the cause.

Chris Pryde – Vice President Admin - contributed significantly to policy and process issues and at the board level contributed on all fronts.

Lisa Stying stepped in as Social Coordinator early in the season, and led the social team. Her inspiration and organisation skills amazed all involved and her contribution was enormous.

Cath Campion lead the Team Managers, returning to the Junior Committee from the Senior Committee in 2011. Cath did a great job coordinating and looking after all of the Team Managers.
